- Possess a valid driver's licence;
- Possess valid CPR & first aid certification;
- Be physically fit;
- Possess high ethical standards and integrity; and
- Have a sound knowledge of the Town of LaSalle.

All applicants shall provide a detailed cover letter and resume highlighting their education, work experience and other desirable characteristics for such a position in our organization.

Experienced applicants shall also provide their last two performance evaluations along with copies of their education and police related training certificates.

Applicants new to policing shall also provide a valid OACP Certificate of Results or CSS Certificate along with all supplementary documents. As a condition of employment, any new applicant, successful in the recruitment process, is required to complete recruit training at the Ontario Police College and be responsible for recruit training course fees.
