



DRE Performance Award Criteria

Description:

The "DRE Performance Award" recognizes an individual who has demonstrated exceptional performance in Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) evaluations over the past year. This award honours those who have significantly contributed to road safety within their jurisdiction.

Criteria:

1. Outstanding DRE Evaluations:

- The recipient must have conducted a significant number of operational DRE evaluations since becoming certified.
- Evaluations should demonstrate thoroughness, accuracy, and adherence to protocols.

2. Contribution to Road Safety:

- The recipient should have actively contributed to ensuring road safety beyond routine evaluations.

Submission Requirements:

• Recommendation:

- Each service can submit one recommendation for the award.
- The recommendation must come from the recipient's own service.

• Supporting Documents:

- A copy of the recipient's rolling log of evaluations must be included with the submission.

Decision Process:

- The co-chairs of the OACP Traffic Safety Committee will review all submissions and decide on the award recipient based on the provided criteria.



DRE Performance Award Criteria

Example of Going Above and Beyond:

- A member of MADD Canada Chapter who conducts presentations at local high schools, educating students about the effects and dangers of impaired driving, exemplifies the type of additional contributions considered for this award.

This award aims to recognize those who not only excel in their technical duties but also take extra steps to educate and protect their communities from the dangers of impaired driving.
