Golden State Killer

Presenter - Retired Detective Sergeant, Ken Clark, from the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office served as a police officer from 1992 – 2021. Clark was the supervisor in the homicide bureau in 2018 and was the lead investigator for the Golden State Killer cold case.

The Golden State Killer, Joseph DeAngelo, was linked to 13 murders, over 50 sexual assaults and over 100 incidents including break and enter, vandalism, peeping and stalking in the 1970's and 1980's in various counties across Northern California.

In 2018, DeAngelo was caught after crime scene DNA matched with genetic material from a distant cousin who was registered to a genealogy website.

Case Studies

Ottawa Police Service investigation involving a gymnastics coach who worked at clubs in Ottawa and Kingston. Between 2014 and 2022, the coach sexually assaulted seven girls who were between the ages of 14 and 17.

Toronto Police Service Human Trafficking Enforcement Unit investigation

“Playing the Long Game: R vs Bedi” is a multi-victim sex trafficking investigation that involved a convicted U.S. child sexual predator who transitioned into a sex trafficker when he was deported back to Canada. He used money from his commercial sexual exploitation to pay for sexual services to satisfy his sexual compulsions and deviances – a disturbing predation loop that ultimately involved four victims.

York Regional Police Service investigation into the sexual assault and murder of an 85-year-old woman who was found dead in a house fire in January 2022. Through investigation and the use of investigative genetic genealogy, a 21-year-old male was identified, arrested and charged.
